Note: Depending on unavoidable circumstances, the schedule and structure of the test may change, and tests may be conducted fully online, fully offline, or in a mix of both modes at SIU's discretion.

Key things to remember about scoring:

- SNAP is **objective** — 4 options per question, pick the correct one.
- **Each wrong answer costs 25% negative marks** — so avoid random guessing.
- Both tests run in **Computer Based Test (CBT)** mode.

SNAP 2026 Test Dates

You can appear for up to **3 tests**. Your **highest score** across all attempts counts — so there's no harm in taking more than one.

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- Exact **timings** for each test will be on your respective Admit Card.

- If an error is found in a paper, the Scrutiny Committee's post-test decision is final.
- Scores across multiple attempts are **not normalized against each other** — but papers are normalised for difficulty across all three tests, so no test date gives an unfair advantage.
- Malpractice or unfair means → immediate disqualification from SIU admissions, possibly applied retrospectively if discovered in later years.

Admit Card — What You Need to Know

- **Download & print** your Admit Card from snaptest.org. Available from Dec 7 (Test 1), Dec 11 (Test 2), and Dec 18, 2026 (Test 3).
- Paste a **recent passport-size colour photo** (taken within the last 6 months) on the Admit Card before test day.
- Carry your Admit Card + **original photo ID** to the centre. Accepted IDs: Passport, Driving License, Voter ID, PAN Card, Aadhar Card, College ID. **Soft copies not accepted.**
- Your Admit Card will be authenticated on test day — keep this authenticated copy safe, you'll need it for the next stage (GE-PI). **Lost cards are not reissued.**
- **Not allowed in the test hall:** phones, calculators, smartwatches, fitness bands, alarm clocks, or any electronic/wearable device.
- You **cannot leave early** or re-enter once you've submitted the test.
- Scope out your test centre **a day in advance** — late arrivals are turned away once gates close, and travel/stay arrangements are on you.
- Scores published by SIU are **final** — no appeals or revaluation.
- PwD / SC / ST / Kashmiri Migrant & Pandit category candidates: upload supporting documents at registration.
- Impersonation, malpractice, or false information at **any stage** (even post-admission) leads to disqualification and possible legal action.

On Exam Day — Guidelines

- Reach the centre at the time on your Admit Card for security & ID checks.
- No entry after the test starts — plan to arrive early.
- Test duration: **60 minutes** (PwD candidates get +20 minutes compensatory time per hour).
- The invigilator checks & authenticates your Admit Card and original ID.
- You can attempt the **4 sections in any order** you like.
- Unfair means = forfeited admission chance and no SNAP score.
- Your **score card** is the official result — print and keep it until your admission process is fully complete.
