

INFRASTRUCTURE

Campus

The architectural design of IIFM's campus is inspired by the historical town of Mandu and the architect, Anant Raje, won a national award for the design. Spreading across 230 acres, its located on a lush green hilltop surrounded on three sides by water bodies, and is known for its wide diversity of flora and wildlife due to its diverse ecosystems. The main building includes the Academic Building, Library, Computer and GIS Centre, Hostel, Student's Mess, and the Administration and Accounts wings. The Academic Building of IIFM includes classrooms and seminar rooms equipped with video conferencing facilities.

Library and Computer Centre

"Vidhya Bharti" library supports users with its wide range of collection of knowledge resources and innovative information services. The IIFM Library has the latest print and digital holdings. The library subscribes to periodicals including newspapers, magazines and foreign journals. The library provides access to online full-text journals and several abstracting databases. It has obtained institutional membership of the National Digital Library, DELNET and MANLIBNET. The library also subscribes to online databases, namely Science Direct, EBSCO, J-Gate, Emerald Marketing e-journals collection, Prowess and Indiastat database for facilitating usage through online access of information.

Hostel, Guest House and Mess

Three hostel blocks namely, Nilgiri, Vindhyachal and Aravalli, having 112 fully furnished rooms are available for accommodating boys and girls separately. The hostel rooms are provided with Internet facility through LAN and Wi-Fi. Guests are accommodated in a separate building with fully equipped rooms and dining amenities. The mess at IIFM is managed by the students and is capable of serving 300 people at a time with nutritious and wholesome food.

Sports Facilities

A wide range of sports facilities are available on campus including Badminton, Lawn Tennis, Table Tennis, Cricket, Football, Volleyball, Basketball, Carrom, Chess and Gym. Intra-institute sports tournaments are organized regularly and the Institute participates in "IRIS-Ranbhoomi" by IIM Indore, MANIT Bhopal and The All-India Forest Sports and Games Meet organized by MoEFCC, Gol. Here at IIFM, every goal scored is cheered, every run scored is applauded and every point won calls for a celebration.


The fieldwork component of the programme is designed with following
